A Successful 2012!

Thanks to our generous donors and dedicated staff, UCAN completed 8,735 surgeries in 2012. That makes over 47,000 surgeries since the clinic opened in April 2007. These surgeries have prevented thousands of unwanted cats and dogs from being born into abuse, neglect and ultimately unnecessary death in local shelters.

Other UCAN accomplishments in 2012 include:

- A targeted cat spay/neuter program in Brown County, OH, thanks to a generous grant from The Joanie Bernard Foundation, pursuant to which 402 cats have been altered and given a rabies and distemper vaccine for just \$15 per cat.
- A Free Roaming Cat Assistance program, again courtesy of a grant from The Joanie Bernard Foundation, pursuant to which over 60 stray/feral cats have been sterilized and received a rabies vaccine for free.
- Established a new, free transport for dogs from Pendleton County, KY to the clinic, with special pricing through Northern Kentucky's Friends of the Shelter of \$15 for surgery and a rabies vaccine.
- Established a new, free transport for both cats and dogs from Gallatin County, KY, with special pricing for surgery and a rabies vaccine through Northern Kentucky's Friends of the Shelter of \$10 for cats and \$15 for dogs.
