Here are some key preventative measures to consider:



- **Microchipping:** Ensure your pet is microchipped and that the owner registration contact information is up-to-date.
- **ID Tags:** Always keep current ID tags on your pet's collar.
- **Secure Your Yard:** Make sure your yard is properly fenced and that gates are securely closed.
- **Supervision:** Always supervise your pet when outdoors, especially in unfamiliar environments.
- **Stay Calm During Fireworks:** If you live in an area with fireworks, keep your pets indoors and create a safe space for them.
- **Spaying/Neutering.** Spaying or neutering your pet can help reduce the urge to roam and potentially get lost.
