To keep pets with the people who love them, our nonprofit clinic operates a wellness practice for pet owners who earn at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty rate.

To help more pets, we seek to expand our team by adding a positive, caring, self-motivated registered veterinary technician or veterinary assistant who enjoys interacting with clients to help our vet provide basic veterinary care, including wellness examinations, dentals, vaccinations, digital radiographs, and laboratory proceedings including urinalysis, bloodwork, fecal exams and other tests. We provide patients with the best veterinary care possible in a respectful, compassionate manner.

The position is part-time, working 2 or 3 days a week on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and/or Thursdays. A good work-personal life balance is important to us, so we offer a schedule where you generally work 9 a.m to 4:30 p.m., with no evening or weekend work.

Benefits include dental and life insurance, substantially discounted services for personal pets, a 401(k) plan with an employer match, and scrubs.

Requirements include the ability to work well on a team, ability to multi-task and stay positive, professional, and accurate in a fast-paced environment, great work ethic and initiative, great attention to detail, proficient and safe restraint of dogs and cats, and the ability to handle a physically demanding job.
