Because of your generosity, pets who once faced an uncertain future are now safe, healthy, and right where they belong — in the loving homes of the families who cherish them. Your support allows us to be there when pets and people need help the most, and the impact you made this year is nothing short of extraordinary.



Thanks to your compassion for at-risk animals in our community, in 2025 we were able to:

- **Perform 12,355 spay and neuter surgeries**, preventing hundreds of thousands of unplanned puppies and kittens who would otherwise have faced homelessness, illness, or overwhelmed shelters. Research shows that sterilized pets live longer, healthier lives — with dramatically lower risks of reproductive cancers, life-threatening infections like pyometra, and injuries from roaming. That means more healthy years, more tail wags, and a lot more hugs and kisses with the people who love them!
- **Save the lives of 110 female pets suffering from pyometra**, a deadly infection that is potentially fatal without surgery. Because of you, these pets didn't lose their lives — they were given a second chance.
- **Provide surgery for 5,894 community cats**, stopping the cycle of unchecked outdoor reproduction and preventing thousands of kittens from being born into lives of hunger, disease, and danger on the streets and overwhelming local shelters during kitten season.
- **Completed 3,606 Friday vaccine clinic appointments**, delivering core vaccines and other basic veterinary care to dogs and cats which will protect them from serious and deadly illnesses.

Together, these services did more than provide veterinary care — they kept families whole. Your support prevented countless beloved pets from being surrendered to shelters and allowed them to remain with the people who love them, including families facing temporary crises such as homelessness, domestic abuse, or financial hardship.

Every number represents a life made better because you chose to care. Every success story is proof that when compassionate people come together, real change happens.

As we look ahead to the coming year, we are inspired by what we can accomplish together. Thank you for standing with pets, families, and our community. We couldn't do this work without you — and because of you, so many futures are brighter.
